





Important Instructions for your Visit

Before your visit:

Please **read** the **Plain Language Statement** concerning the tests which will be conducted at the clinic visit and the **Consent form**.

Please try and avoid the following:

- (1) **Smoking** for **4 hours** before appointment time.
- (2) Long Acting Reliever Medication* for 12 hours before your appointment time.
- (3) Short Acting Reliever Medication* for 4 hours before appointment time.

*Refer to the last page for a medication list.

If you regularly use medication, please bring a list of those medications to your visit.

If you are a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or currently have any symptoms, including fever, cough, sneezing, sore throat or runny nose, please reschedule your appointment or call 1800 110 711 to discuss.

If you need to cancel or reschedule your appointment, please call to let us know as soon as possible.



The Respiratory and Sleep Laboratory is located on Level 5 of the Harold Stokes Building of Austin Health.

FROM THE AUSTIN TOWER CAR-PARK

- 1. Make a note of where you have parked (there are several carpark levels).
- 2. Take the Carpark Lift to Level 3.
- 3. Exit the lift and make a sharp right turn (almost a U-turn).
- 4. Follow the blue line on the floor of the corridor (for about 400 metres) towards the Harold Stokes Building.
- 5. The Harold Stokes Lifts are on your left. If you reach the couches, you've gone too far.
- 7. Take this lift to Level 5.
- 8. Exit the lift and follow the signs to the Respiratory and Sleep Laboratory.

FROM THE BURGUNDY STREET OUTPATIENT DROP OFF POINT

- 1. Enter Harold Stokes Building. This is Level 3.
- 2. Walk diagonally right, following the blue line, to the Harold Stokes Building.
- 3. Take the lift to Level 5.
- 4. Exit the lift and follow the signs to the Respiratory and Sleep Laboratory.

FROM HEIDELBERG TRAIN STATION

- 1. Follow signs from the Train Station towards the Austin Hospital.
- 2. Cross Studley Road at the pedestrian crossing.
- 3. Enter the carpark and take the Lift to Level 3.
- 4. Exit the lift and follow the blue line to the Harold Stokes building.
- 9. Take the lifts on your left to Level 5.
- 10. Exit the lift and follow the signs to the Respiratory and Sleep Laboratory.
